CCC called a meeting on July 1, 2020 at the ColoRODans in Longmont. Attendance was 13 member clubs which is not a quorum. No official business could be completed.

The treasure reported that CCCC has a current balance of \$29, 609 with no income projected for the remainder of 2020. With Cruiz'n Havana and airport show cancelled for 202, there have been serious consequences to the CCCC budget. A deficit of about \$9000 is projected for 2020.






