






On Sunday, May 6, 28 RMTC members met with Harry Edwards and his 1929 4-door Model A Ford and Rich Carlson and his 1928 2-door Model A Ford. Both cars are fully restored and ran like well-tuned clocks. After some detailed instruction on how the Model A power train functions and the best sequence to follow to get them started, each member had the opportunity to start up and drive both cars. One member even got to try his hand at crank starting the 1928. It only took a partial turn of the crank to get it putting smoothly. With a three speed stick shift on the floor, we learned that Ford referred to the gears as Low, Intermediate, and High and the gears are not syncro-meshed. The gears are not beveled, so double clutching while shifting is a must. The way the drive trains function; the different gauges and controls; the safety features; and the way they drive were illustrative of how technology has changed cars and the way we drive them. They both even came with factory installed "ac" that you get by pushing out the bottom of the windshield. Both cars were a treat to drive and handled quite well. Thanks Harry and Rich for taking the chance on allowing "strangers" to drive their beautiful cars.



The National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB) is reminding people that vehicles flooded by Hurricane Harvey may soon be appearing for sale around the nation. The NICB, member companies, law enforcement, and auto auction companies work to identify the vehicles that have had an insurance claim filed and to process them for sale. All of the totaled cars will be retitled with the Dept. Of Motor Vehicles indicating that the vehicle has been flood damaged. The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) is also entered into the NICB's VINCheck and the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS). The VINCheck is available as a free public service at www.nicb.org/theft_and_fraud_awareness/vincheck. The system is to "assist in determining if a vehicle has been reported stolen, but not recovered, or has been reported as a salvage vehicle by cooperating NICB member insurance companies." A VIN is required to conduct a search. This information comes from the National Insurance Crime Bureau.
